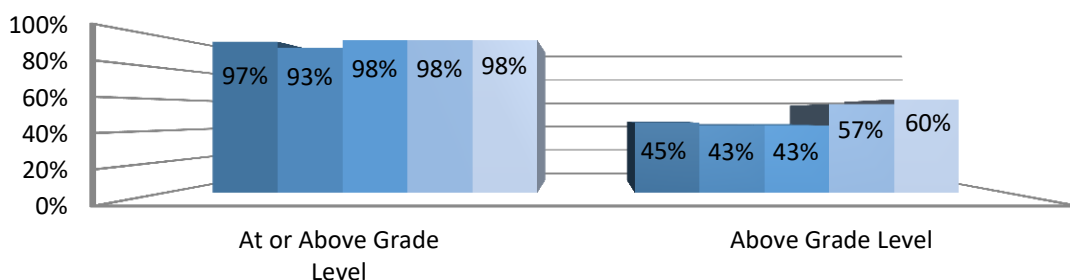

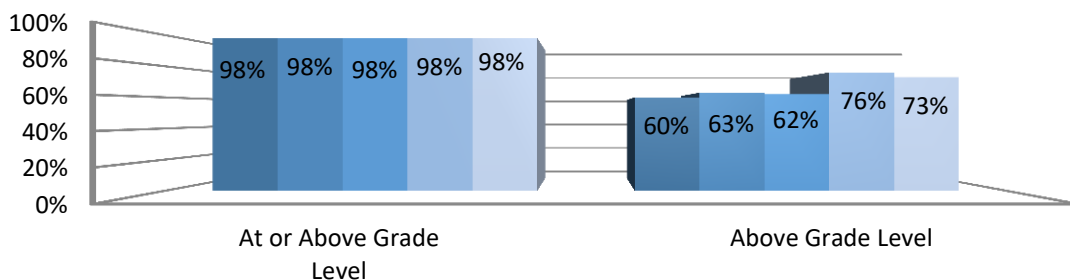
How have Mazel Day School students in Grade 4-8 performed on the Stanford?

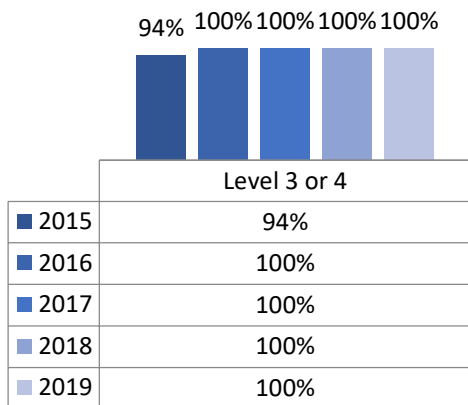

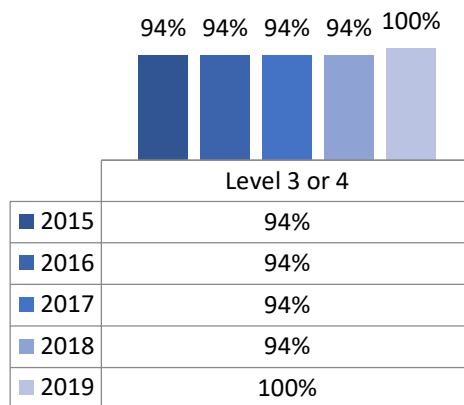

Noetic Learning Math Contest

In Spring 2018, Mazel Lower Schoolers competed with students across the country from 520 private and public schools in the **Noetic Learning Math Contest**, a national mathematics contest for elementary and middle school students. Our students ranked 14th out of 520 and scored higher than a top New York City school for the gifted.

In Fall 2019, Mazel Lower and Middle School students competed in the Noetic Contest and achieved "**National Honor Roll**" medals. We are so proud of our students who scored in the top 10% of all participants in their grade level nationally, including third-grader Ethan K., fourth-graders Gregory S., Isadore L., Emmanuel C., and fifth-grader Aaron B. Aaron was also **the highest scoring winner in New York State!!!!** In addition, a number of our students scored in the upper 50% of all students of their grade nationally, receiving "**Honorable Mention**" certificates.
